Demolition of Existing Bungalow and construction of 3 detached dwellings without compliance with condition 2 in relation to decision notice PA22/08394 dated 22.12.2022.

Resolved. It was proposed by Cllr Brooks seconded by Cllr Coakley and agreed to recommend the application for refusal due to the fact that the Council's views remain unchanged to those given at the planning meeting of 15th December 2022, when the PA22/08394 application was discussed. The resolution then being; 'To recommend the application for refusal on the grounds of overcrowding with very little amenity space. Councillor's also felt the visual appearance would not fit in with the current street scene.' (5 support, 1 abstention (AL))
